

PROFESSOR JULIE QUINLIVAN

Professor Quinlivan is Director of the Professional Services Review, an Independent Statutory Agency responsible for regulation of Medicare and the PBS.

An obstetrician and gynaecologist, she has been a Unit Head in several tertiary hospitals. She currently works in private practice in Barton, a block away from Parliament House, and is Chair of the RANZCOG ACT Committee.

Professor Quinlivan is a former Pro Vice Chancellor and Executive Dean of Medicine at the University of Notre Dame Australia and has current professorial affiliations with UNDA and ANU.

She has published over 280 books, book chapters, original research articles and conference proceedings including publications in leading journals such as NEJM, Lancet, JAMA and Human Nature.

She is editor-in-chief of JPOG and on the editorial boards of several other journals.

Professor Quinlivan has been Chair of the WA Clinical Senate and has been a member of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for 16 years.

She has also played a senior role in health services management as a Governing Councillor of North Metropolitan Health Service and subsequently as a Non-Executive Director of South Metropolitan Health Services in Western Australia.

She has also played a senior role in the TAFE sector as Deputy Chair and Non-Executive Director of West Coast Institute of Training and subsequently as Non-Executive Director of South Metropolitan TAFE.

She was also a former Non-Executive Director of Moreland Community Health Service in Victoria and several other Boards.
